## Corporate Background

In April 1997, **Vancouver Island Powder Coating 1997 Ltd.** purchased the assets of Vancouver Island Powder Coating Ltd. which was running as a one person coating operation in the Cedar area south of Nanaimo. The business has expanded by 30% per year and now employs 5-7 people. The business is owned and operated by Bruce Rogers with Larry Renaud supervising production.

## Goals

Our goal is to consistently provide top quality work and customer service, at a fair price. As a custom job shop we are coating different items each day. We take pride in the fact that we focus our energies on ways of accomplishing the challenging jobs rather than reasons why we can't do the job. We will tackle any job as long as we can preplan the work so that we are assured that the job will be done well.

## Facilities

Located on an open 1 acre lot in the Cedar area of Southern Nanaimo, we operate our Custom Job shop from a newly expanded 5200 sq. foot facility. The plant utilizes 2 coating lines in a batch format, allowing us to accommodate everything from one small piece of robotics to 2000 pound pipe spools for the Municipal Water market.

For pretreatment we offer sandblasting (both internal and external for pipe spools) beadblasting and 3 stage hot iron phosphate immersion system capable of handling items up to 26' long and 7' wide by 7'high. Higher items may be accommodated but it is a function of the overall configuration.

We run 2 full size powder booths and one mini booth. Our main oven is a natural gas fired, 1.5 million btu convection oven 27, feet long and 8' high by 8' wide, with a second smaller oven for the smaller jobs.
